# Round Nine Review

Wanneroo City won a ten goal thriller after a 7-3 win against Balga at Wanneroo Reserve. "We conceded in the first few minutes and equalised a few minutes after and from then on controlled the game," Wanneroo Coach Matt Debarro said. "Balga have some good players and coach, Bobby has them playing good football, a late red card didn't help them but on a whole I think our experience and quality going forward was a bit much on the day. They are a good team though, I can see them as the big improvers this season." Balga were ahead after only two minutes, Nahom Michael scoring, but the home side were level five minutes later Chris Marshall headed home. The big defender added a second, and further first half goals to Connor Lynch, after a good cut back from John Monterosso, before Monterosso converted from the spot to make it 4-1 at the break. Gareth Crawley was then sent off for Balga, and Monterosso scored from the resulting free kick. Andreas Bouzinekis pulled one back for Balga, but Monterosso completed his hat trick to make it 6-2. Tom Black headed home the seventh for Wanneroo, but Lee James reduced the margin late.

Forrestfield United maintained their lead at the top of the All Flags Division Two table with a 5-2 win against Curtin University at Hartfield Park on Saturday evening. "I have to give credit to Curtin for trying to play a good brand of football and never giving up even when they went down to 10 men. We always knew it was going to be a tough game as we failed to beat them last year, I know they have had a slow start but I can see them taking points off some big sides this year," Forrestfield winger Rhys Loxley said. "At the moment we are playing consistently good football creating a lot of chances and being stingy in defence but we cannot get ahead of ourselves and get carried away as there are three other sides waiting for us to slip up and pounce, we just have to take each week one game at a time."

The home side were ahead early, Ben Rogers sending Jordan Hart clear and he finished low past the keeper. It was 2-0 when Loxley crossed to Rogers, who scored from six meters. The visitors pulled one back when Carlo Chiellini scored a stunning free kick giving Brad Effie no chance. Rogers made it 3-1, but Curtin weren't giving in and reduced the margin again, Dilip Thapa, lobbing Effie from the edge of the penalty area. But they were then reduced to ten men when Chiellini was sent off. Forrestfield made their advantage count, Rogers firing home from close-range, and he completed his hat-trick when he raced on to a sublime through ball from Kaan Karacan to finish low past the keeper.

In other games Rockingham City edged out Melville City 3-2 at the Len Shearer Reserve. Paul Larvin, Calum Rothwell and Shane Boyle were on target for the visitors, while Barry Richards and Mark Lucas both scored from the spot for the home side. Joondalup City won 2-1 in a hard fought game against Kingsway Olympic, while Quinns beat Ellenbrook United 3-1 at Arbor Grove Reserve.

### Reserves Match Report

Wanneroo City vs Balga - 13/6/2015

Aleer Majoll's late winner gave Balga reserves a 3-2 victory over Wanneroo City SC in an animated end to end spectacle at Kingsway sports complex keeping them only 5 points adrift of league leaders Quinns FC.

Majoll's late strike and two spectacular goals from Ajana Kuol and Tahir Kulelija mean the boys in green have won their last three games and are unbeaten in four. The away side were made to work hard for the victory and they seemed to be lacking the same panache that marked their last two victories against Melville & Rockingham.

Balga made advances early on and perhaps should have been at least 1-0 up after forcing the home keeper into making two remarkable saves. Things weren't looking good for the home side when after only 15 minutes into proceedings they were reduced to 10 men after a wreckless challenge on Amir Ali gave the referee no other choice but to show red.

Balga failed to capitalise and with only 20 minutes on the clock found themselves 1-0 down when Wanneroo were awarded a penalty for a soft tackle just inside the box. Balga goalkeeper Ton Thongnam managed to get a hand to the initial effort but unfortunately parried to the Wanneroo striker who made no mistake second time around.

The visitor's levelled things up ten minutes later when Tahir Kulelija raced clear to score his second goal in as many games. Kulelija's previous topflight experience was evident as he sent a searing 20-yard shot high past the keeper. However Wanneroo failed to give up and remained to be a threat on the break. Thongnam again saved dramatically from a set piece and after some intensive pressure the home side found themselves in the lead once again. With both some confusion amongst the Balga defence and the referee failing to spot a hand ball the home side pounced on a loose ball and tapped in from close range.

After the break, Balga appeared to be more fluent on the ball and manager Adrian Caloiero went searching for an equalizer replacing Kidane Berhe with Ajana Kuol. The gamble paid off as only 12 minutes later the Sudanese attacker scored with a powerful header from a delightful cross delivered by Majoll.

With time running out and Wanneroo showing signs of fatigue, Caloiero's answer was a novel one, switching to three at the back by replacing Mohammed Barrie with Phil Pyrchia and throwing Majoll up top alongside Taj and Kulelija. Pyrchia played a huge role as with only minutes to spare it was the trusty centre backs clever flick that allowed Majoll to take a touch and tee himself up before crashing a thunderous right-foot finish into the bottom corner from just inside the box.

It was a Balga display that will have given coach Adrian Caloiero much pain before the pleasure of victory, some slick passing and lively attacking being mixed with dreadful defending that would invite greater punishment should it be repeated against full strength side. "Mentally it can sometimes be harder to play against 10 than it is to play against 11 so we had a look at the system at half-time as it just didn't seem to be working. When Wanneroo began to fatigue we moved a couple of people around to see how they would cope and it paid dividends", Caloiero said.

"I have to give credit to the boys for not giving up, the attitude shown today really demonstrated the depth we have in the squad. Yes at times we were poor, and there are definitely areas that we need to be working on in training ahead of Forrestfield in two weeks time but I'm delighted to be taking home all 3 points."

Balga have met Forrestfield United 22 times in the league. The first time the two clubs met however was in 1981 in the State Cup, when 2nd tier Balga caused an upset and beat top flight Forrestfield United 2-1. Forrestfield went on to finish runners-up in the State Premier Division that season.

Out of the 22 leagues games, Forrestfield United have won thirteen times, there have only been three draws, while Balga have won on six occasions.

It's been a long time since Balga last beat Forrestfield, that was in 2001 in the Amateur Premier Division when Balga won 2-1. The last time the black and greens beat Forrestfield in the Saturday competition was in 1991 in the State League First Division.

### Our Opponents



Forrestfield United's have a long history in WA football, and were originally known as Cottestloe when they entered the State League competition in 1962. Cottestloe later merged in 1971 with SMA United (Swan Migrant Association) to become SMA Cottelsoe. As SMA were based in the Ascot area it was decided to change the club name to "Ascot Soccer Club" the following year.

In 1974 the club became WA Champions when they took our the State Premier Division title by nine points. In 1978 Ascot won the last Ampol Cup (Night Series), and that trophy is proudly on display in the Forrestfield clubrooms.

In late 1978 Ascot were in merger discussions with Fourth Division club Kalamunda United, who were based at Hartfield Park, Forrestfield. The merger went ahead, and the new name of the merged club was to become Forrestfield United in 1979.

Forrestfield have had many highs and lows since 1979, which included a stint in the Amateur League from 1993 to 2004. But the club is now riding high in Division Two, and look set to return to Division One in the very near future.

# FLASHBACK

1984

The 1984 season ended with Balga reaching its goal of promotion to the best possible league in Western Australia. Balga battled it out with Forrestfield United for top spot on the league table throughout the second half of the season, however a loss to Forrestfield and Cockburn ended hopes of a championship. A win against Swan Athletic with two games to go guaranteed a top two finish and promotion to the State League Premier Division.

Jimmy Pearson took over the reigns at Forrestfield as their new coach after their relegation from the top flight the previous year. It was a shaky start to the 1984 season for Forrestfield, the club lost their first game and then drew their next match. However after that the Hartfield Park outfit dominated the league, winning eighteen of their next twenty games, only dropping points in draws against Bassendean Caledonian and Kelmscott.
