Round Two Review

The round begun on a Friday night with Forrestfield United and Wanneroo City fighting out a 2-2 draw at Hartfield Park. The visitors took the lead early from the penalty spot, John Monterosso making it two goals in as many matches for his new club. But both keepers were the stars on the night. Daniel Agudelo and Brad Effie were outstanding between the sticks, but Forrestfield were wasteful in front of goal too. But after the break Rhys Loxley levelled for the host's midway through the second half. Scott Campbell then put the Roos back in front and it looked like they would go home with the points, but deep into stoppage time David Ferrante equalised. "I want to thank Forrestfield for helping us out with a fixture change and we are happy to return the favour anytime," Wanneroo coach Matt Debarro said. "It was heartbreaking to not take all three points, but I think a fair result between two very good footballing teams. Well done to my boys and well done to Rod Banjac and his team, the crowd was all entertained by the spectacle, it was a great night."

In the Saturday games Melville City made it back-to-back wins with 3-0 victory against Ellenbrook United at Arbor Grove Reserve. Christian Long gave City the lead, before Mitch Barrington added the second, and Barry Richards the third. Curtin University were made to fight hard for their 2-1 win against Kelmscott Roos at Frye Park. Keeper Sam Cogle was outstanding for the home side, but he could do nothing when Dilip Thapa opened the scoring in the first half. The home side levelled through Jon Ingram just after half time. Curtin had the chance to retake the lead in the 70th minute when Robert Keegan was brought down in the box, but Carlo Chiellini penalty hit the post. But the visitors got their reward late with Nathan Smith scoring.

Fremantle City and Rockingham City shared the spoils in 1-1 draw at Hilton Reserve Monty Grigo gave Rockingham the lead, but Sam Smith levelled for Fremantle. Kingsway Olympic scored their first win with 4-2 win against nine men Balga at Kingsway Reserve. Oliver Hilton scored twice for the home side, while Dejan Gurovski and Andy O'Neill added the others. Kyall Osbourne and Lee James scored for Balga, but James was later sent off along with keeper Olie Rigler. In other games Quinns FC won the local derby against Joondalup City 2-0 at Illuka Sports Complex.

Balga have met the Kelmscott Roos twenty times in the league, with Balga winning eight times, Kelmscott have also won on eight occasions while there has been four draws. Sixteen of these fixtures have been played in the Saturday semi-professional competition, while the four played in the 2010 and 2013 seasons occurred in the Sunday Amateur League.

The first match was in 1981 when Balga had just been promoted to the old second division (now First Division) and thumped Kelmscott 5-1, however Kelmscott returned the favour with a 5-2 win later in the year at Frye Park.

Our Opponents



Kelmscott Roos were formed in 1969 as Kelmscott Soccer Club, and played in West Ham United's famous claret and blue colours. In 1970, the club joined the Amateur Soccer Association and went straight into the Premier Division where they finished a credible sixth in their first full season. The following year they finished third, followed by a runners-up position in 1972. It was decided by the club to join the Soccer Federation (semi-pro Saturday league) Second Division in 1973, where Kelmscott held their own and ended up in sixth place. The club won promotion to the First Division in 1978, where they stayed for eight seasons. During this time Kelmscott moved venues from Frye Park to the new enclosed venue at Pries Park in 1983.

1985 was start of the golden era for Kelmscott, when former English international Trevor Brooking played a couple of guest games, and they also went on to win promotion to the State Premier Division. The end of the 1986 season resulted in relegation from the top flight, however Kelmscott defied everything by winning the State Cup (D'orsogna Cup). Kelmscott went on to win the First Division in 1988 and 1989, and were allowed promotion into the Super League for the 1990 season. This is when the club changed their name to the Kelmscott Roos and their colours to green and gold. After making the finals in 1990, the club was on the decline, and suffered relegation from the top league in 1993. It was decided by the senior arm of the club to merge with Gosnells/Ferndale United in 1995 to become Southside United, who later changed their name back to Gosnells City.

The Kelmscott Roos Junior Soccer Club continued, and ten years later in 2005 the club re-entered a senior team in the amateur competition. In 2012, Kelmscott Roos then applied to re-join the Saturday competition for the 2013 season.

Round One Review

Curtin University and Kingsway Olympic opened the season on Friday 10th April at Edinburgh Oval, with both sides sharing the spoils after a 1-1 draw. The visitors were ahead after only five minutes, when they won a penalty. Wayne Culverwood saw his spot kick well saved by Mackenzie Ferguson, but Culverwood was quickest to react and fired the rebound home. The home side pressed but Rory Binnie, Jon Krawec and Eddie Tikoft couldn't convert their chances.

But five minutes into the second half Curtin's pressure finally paid dividends. Nathan Smith's cross was turned home by Binnie. Kingsway keeper Jonstone Walker made a number of fine saves to deny Curtin and moments before the final whistle Jordan Parr cleared the ball off the line, to earn a hard fought point for Tom Kilkelly's side.

Rockingham City started the season with a 2-0 win against Ellenbrook United at Lark Hill, with goals from Blad Atkinson and Paul Larvin. New Balga coach Bobby Taneski got off to a great start when Kyall Osbourne opened the scoring at Princess Road Reserve, against Fremantle City. But the visitors hit back with a free-kick from Mick D'Souza five minutes before half time that left Balga keeper Oli Rigler with no chance. Only two minutes later Fremantle found themselves in front, a missed penalty shot rebounded from Rigler's save that resulted in an own goal from Gary Shorto. In the closing minutes Balga desperately tried for the equaliser, but it was Cameron McTear on the counter-attack who scored to make sure Fremantle got the points.

Wanneroo new coach Matt Debarro won his first game in charge, after coming from 2-0 down to beat Joondalup City at Kingsway Reserve. Connor Lynch brought them back into the game, while skipper Luke Woodard, John Monterosso and own goal win it for The Roos. In the final game Quinns beat Kelmscott Roos 6-1 at Gumblossom Park.

FLASHBACK

ROUND TWELVE - 28/6/1986

Kelmscott travelled to Princess Road to meet Balga in the Round 12 clash of the top flight State League competition in 1986. Balga were on a good run, with only one loss in their previous four league games in the competition, however newly promoted Kelmscott had a tough start to their first ever season in WA's top league and were winless after their first six matches, however the club had a good 3-1 win in their last match against Bayswater Inter in the hope of avoiding relegation.

This was the era when both clubs were competing for the "Brian Burke Trophy" (the WA Premier at the time) as well as the league points. In a hard fought encounter, the game was drawn 1-1, with A. Ollis scoring for Kelmscott while Barry Neylon got the goal for Balga. Balga went on to beat Forrestfield United the following week, and climbed to sixth spot in the league, our highest ever position in the top flight during our three years there.
