Round Four Review

League leaders Quinns suffered their first defeat of the All Flags Division Two season after they were beaten 3-2 by the improving Balga at Gumblossom Park. The visitors were ahead on 20 minutes, with Jimmy Taneski scoring, but Liam McGurk levelled five minutes before the break, tapping home from close-range. The home side hit the front just after half time through Jon McGahern, but they then had Jay Marsden sent off. Then on a quick counter attack Balga equalised through Lee James, and Quinns were then reduced to nine men when Callum Trayner was shown a second yellow card. Balga made their numerical advantage count with the winner with five minutes remaining. James sent clear from a neat through ball and he fired home much to pleasure of the visiting supporters.

“It was a massive three points away from home for us,” Balga keeper Ollie Rigler said. “We showed tremendous character, patience, determination and belief that we could come away with the points.” The gaffer has given us the hunger and mind set to know we can put a stamp on the game and has let everyone know we're not here to make up numbers. The score line didn't reflect the way we played, and we should've taken a few more chance, but to come away with the win against a side that's had a very good start is great for us.”

In other games, Fremantle City and Rockingham City sit joint top of the table, as they both continued their good starts to the season. Monty Grigo and Shane Boyle were the scorers as Rockingham beat Kelmscott Roos 2-1 at Fyre Park, while Nicky O'Brien, Andrew Morrow and Danny Clapham were on target as Fremantle beat Wanneroo City 3-0 at Hilton Reserve. In other games Ben Rogers scored a hat trick after Forrestfield United beat Ellenbrook United 5-1 at Arbor Grove Reserve. Also on target for Rod Banjac's side were Rhys Loxley and Jordan Hart.

Kingsway Olympic moved up to fifth on the table after a 2-1 win against Melville City, at Kingsway Reserve. Brett Cutting and Ryan Fielder were on target for the home side, while Mark Lucas scored for City. In the final game of the round Curtin University and Joondalup City fought out a 1-1 draw at Raphael Park. It looked like the home side would take the points, after Nathan Smith had given them a first half lead. But in the 93rd minute the visitors snatched a dramatic point, with Rhys Booth scoring from a free kick, which gave keeper Ranjeet Sekhon no chance. “We are furious to have dropped two points with the last kick of the game,” Curtin Assistant Coach Campbell Ballantyne said. “We should have really put the game to bed before then, but that's football.”

Our Opponents



The Curtin University Soccer Club was founded in 1992, when they joined the Fourth Division of the Amateur competition. During their first decade, the club spent their time between the Fifth and Third Divisions. In 2006 Curtin were promoted to the Amateur Second Division for the first time, and spent a number of years consolidating their position.

The big break came in 2011, with a number of amateur clubs above them leaving to play Saturday football, the club were promoted to the First Division from fifth place. Their first year in Division One almost led to promotion again, but the club just missed out at the end and had to settle for third spot.

Curtin would make no mistake in 2013, and were crowned Sunday League First Division champions with only one loss to their name. The club then applied to join the State League, and were accepted by Football West.

The visitors went close to the equaliser on the half hour, but Nathan Smith headed wide when well placed. The visitors levelled on the hour, Dave Ashworth heading home powerfully from a free kick. Quinns almost nicked all three points late, but a stunning save from Curtin custodian Ranjeet Sekhon denied them.

Wanneroo City also continued their good start to the campaign with a 4-0 win against Ellenbrook United at the Wanneroo Sporting Complex. The home side dominated possession and a brace from Connor Lynch and singles to Joey Woodin and Josh Beddis were on the score sheet. "I was very pleased with the boys today, they played great football, and it was scary thought to think we are still capable of more," Roos coach Matt Debarro said. "It was out first clean sheet, another home win and a clean sweep for all 3 teams winning, a great day for the club."
