Welcome to Princess Road Reserve, and Balga Soccer Club.

A further warm welcome to all of our committee, sponsors, life members and supporters, and our guests today from the Joondalup City Football Club.

Today we expect a tough opponent whom have started the season a quite slow and definitely by all account should have won a few more than what the statistics suggest. They bring a British style mentality of never say die attitude, mixed in with a few tough challenges we expect a tough opponent. Nonetheless we expect a home win today, after two losses we have bounced back 3 unbeaten and last week we dropped 2 points against Curtin, with 10mins to go we looked in cruise control and dominating the game. Curtin did not capitalise further on their dominance and we turned up their pressure late in the half as we pushed for an equaliser before the break but Ranjeet Sekhon was a wall in goal for the visitors keeping Curtin in the lead at the half time break.

The second half was brought to life in just minutes as Taneski broke through Curtin's lines and made it 1-1 inside the opening few minutes. Curtin turned to their bench for some spice as they introduced Salhah for Kristian Beven but it was our team who took the lead through Middleton's own goal. With just 10 minutes to play the introduction of Salhah payed off as he buried the ball into the bottom corner of Ollie Rigler's net to restore parity to the match.

With the game heading into its last few minutes Curtin retook the lead when the impressive Smith bundled the ball in after what looked like a foul on Toland in the lead up. It looked like Curtin would take all three points from Princess Park Reserve for the second season running but Ahmetanovic's 94th minute free kick cannoned in off the upright to rescue a point for our side.

Five rounds into the 2015 State League Division Two season, and the current league table already has the two pre-season favourites for the league, Rockingham City and Forreestfield United, in the top two positions. Rockingham have won four and drew one, while Forreestfield failed to win their first two games, but have since hit their strap and won their last three straight. Fremantle City who were top after four rounds, lost to Forreestfield last week, and are now third on goal difference.

Melvile City started the season on fire, but have lost points in recent games, while last year's relegated Division One club Wanneroo City will be hoping to go straight back up. New coach Matt Debarro has signed some quality players for the club, and will consider themselves a chance of a top two position.

Kelmscott have come close in a couple of their games, losing by the odd goal, but were taught a lesson last week against Joondalup City in a 6-2 thrashing. Ellenbrook are currently last and have only scored three goals.

Our very own Balga have improved this year, even though we lost on our first two games of the season. Since then we have won two and drawn one with seven points. Only three points away from second place.

This year apart from the bottom two teams, the league looks as tight as ever and it will be interesting to see how the table looks as we approach the half-way stage of the season in several weeks.

Joondalup City and Balga have met on six occasions, four of those games was when the club was called Heathridge Soccer Club.

The first encounter in 2009 will be remembered by most from both clubs. It was the year former Heathridge coach Joe Sweeny joined Balga, and many Heathridge players followed him to the black and greens. Balga ended up winning 1-0. The return match ended up in a 1-1 draw, which all but ended Balga's promotion hopes. Heathridge got revenge in 2010 by winning both games.

Last year both clubs met each other for the first time in the State League competition. Joondalup City won the first game here at Princess Road Reserve in stoppage time by three goals to two, while in the reverse fixture, Balga were well and truly beaten in a seven to three loss.

Our Opponents



The Joondalup City Soccer Club was founded in 1989 as Heathridge Celtic, however the "Celtic" part of the name was dropped in the mid-1990's.

Since their formation Heathridge were mainly focused on their juniors and would become one of the biggest juniors clubs in Western Australia. In 2007 the club decided to enter the Amateur League for the first time, where it achieved instant success. It won the Fourth Division in its first season, and then went on to win the Third Division in 2008. After three seasons in the Amateur Second Division, the club decided to join the State League, where they finished sixth in 2012 and became champions in 2013. Due to the start of the NPL the club were not promoted to the State League First Division in 2014.

Round Five Review

Balga continued their resurgence under new coach Bobby Taneski after an entertaining 3-3 draw against Curtin University at Princess Road Reserve. A 94th minute equaliser from Dinko Ahmetanovic rescued the point for the home side that are unbeaten in their last three games. Eddie Tikoft had given Curtin the lead after only 12 minutes, finishing from a corner. Balga pressed hard for the equaliser for the rest of the half, but they found Curtin keeper Ranjeet Sekhon in good form. But there was little the Curtin custodian could do when Balga levelled early in the second half, Dimce Taneski firing home after a goalmouth scramble. The home side were ahead on the hour, with Kye Middleton putting the ball into his own net. But second half substitute Khaled Salhah restored parity with 10 minutes remaining, firing low past Ollie Rigler. The visitors thought they had won it in on 88 minutes, Smith bundling the ball home from close-range. But with the last kick of the match Balga got there deserved point. Ahmetanovic's free kick beat Sekhon, and crashed off the upright and into the net to set off wild celebrations from the Balga players and supporters alike.

The Northern derby between Wanneroo City and Kingsway Olympic at Wanneroo Reserve also ended in a 3-3 draw. The home side dominated early and Tom Black scored early before Stuart Siddall headed home a second at the near post. Tom Kilkelly's side was back in the game before half time, with Andy O'Neill scoring. The hosts regained their two goal advantage with Black added his second, before O'Neill scored his second to set up a tense finish. Then late on Kingsway won a penalty for handball and Ian McKean fired low past Cory Hugo to give both sides a share of the spoils.

In other games Forrestfield United beat Fremantle City at Hartfield Park, with Ben Rogers and Chris Perrott on target, while Rockingham City won the top of the table clash against Quinns 3-1 at Lark Hill. The home had to come from behind after Quinns scored early, but an own goal, and others to Shane Boyle and Gersham Rowland gave the home side the points. "I was really pleased with Saturday's win in really difficult conditions," Rockingham coach Rob Crerar said. "To come back from a goal down showed the character in our group and that our younger players are maturing." Melville City thrashed Kelmscott Roos 7-1, with Christian Long bagging a hat-trick, with others from 3, Thomas Jeges, Logan Mclsaac, Simon El Chami and Blake Readwin. In the final game Joondalup City beat Ellenbrook United 6-2. Mark Thornton scored a hat trick, Bobby Irving a brace and Danny Welsh the other.

FLASHBACK

1980

In 1980 Balga took out the Third Division (now called Division Two) championship by two points over University and gained promotion to the second tier. Balga also went on to win the top four cup 2-0 against University. Brian Callaghan took out the Second Division Fairest and Best and K. Winstanley was the league's top goal scorer, with 18 goals.

Balga also had its best D'Orsogna (State) Cup run in 1980 by reaching the quarter-finals, not bad for a team that wasn't even in the top 2 divisions during that season. Balga caused the upset of the year in the Second Round when it defeated high flying East Fremantle Tricolore 2-1 at home, before losing 1-0 to North Perth Croatia in the game that decided the semi-finalist. The Reserves also had a great season, by finishing runners up in the league.
