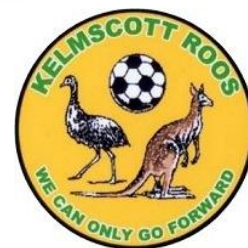

Champions Dianella White Eagles host Curtin University in the late game at Dianella Reserve tonight and will be looking to continue their unbeaten season, while relegated Kelmscott Roos will be looking to end their final three games off well, starting with a trip to Princess Road Reserve to take on Balga. It's a local derby as Joondalup City meet Wanneroo City, while Canning City host Carramar Shamrock Rovers at Burrendah Reserve.

In the final game Murdoch University Melville will look to consolidate their top four spot when they visit Wotton Reserve to take on Morley Windmills. Morley drew at Curtin last week and will look for some home comforts on Saturday, while MUM was beaten for the first time in seven games by Wanneroo, and skipper Mark Lucas said it was a tight game. "Last Saturday was a close game and ultimately was decided by a penalty which was anything but clear cut," he said. "Wanneroo are a very hard side to break down when they sit back and defend like they did. We didn't think we deserved to lose and a draw would have been fair. We have a good belief and team spirit in our squad and have been in good form and were unlucky to lose last week. We will keep pushing and have put top four back in our own hands which wasn't the case six weeks ago."

Lucas said Morley have had the wood on them this season, and he hopes to turn that around on Saturday and press for a top four spot. "The game at Morley will be interesting as they have actually beaten us twice already this season, so we will look to turn this around. It's always a good trip to Morley as we have some old friends there, so we will be looking to get the three points Saturday," he explained, "The top four race will certainly have a few more twists and turns as it has over recent weeks and Kingsley, Wanneroo and Gosnells are all very good sides so will be a shame one has to miss out but we will be trying to make sure it isn't us."

One game of the round has already been played. Gosnells City defeated Kingsley Westside 3-2 on Thursday night.

# FLASHBACK

## 1981

1981 was our first season in the second tier (now known as the State League First Division) of WA football.
